22.1 In 2017, there was only one decision involving Muslim law in the Singapore Law Reports, that is, the five-judge Court of Appeal decision of *TMO v TMP*.<sup>1</sup> This decision (and the High Court decision that was the subject of the appeal) was discussed at some length in a previous edition of this Chapter.<sup>2</sup>

22.2. Separately, no grounds of decision were issued by the MUIS<sup>3</sup> Appeal Board in 2017.
